Marvin Partlow, affectionately known as "Bug," was born on December 10, 1971. His proud parents are Willie and Alice Partlow. He was the third oldest of four boys. Marvin accepted Christ at an early age. He often attended Greater Emmanuel Institutional Church of God in Christ.

Marvin was always smiling, fun-loving and cracking jokes whenever he was around. He always had a way of making you laugh. He was overly protective of the females in his immediate family and always offered unsolicited advice lovingly.

Marvin was educated in the Detroit Public Schools system. He graduated from Murray Wright High School in 1989. After high school, Marvin enlisted into the United States Navy where he served on the USS Ingersoll during the Persian Gulf War where he made many lifelong friends. During his naval career, he received several medals and honors: Good Conduct Award, National Defense Service Award, Sea Service Deployment Ribbons, Coast Guard Operations Ribbon, Southeast Asia Service Medal with Bronze Star, and a Meritorious Unit Commendation. Marvin received an honorable discharge in 1995.

He later attended ITT Technical Institute where he obtained his Associates Degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering. Marvin was valedictorian of his graduating class. He was currently pursuing his advanced degree toward

his bachelor's in that field.

Marvin was currently employed at the John D. Dingell VA Medical Center of Detroit, where he worked in the food services department.

Marvin cherished his family and he loved children. He always wanted the children in his life to call him their "godfather." Marvin had an infectious love of fast cars and nice clothes.

Marvin departed this life on Wednesday, July 27, 2016.

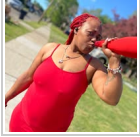
