Mrs. Mearon Louise Parker Nance was born January 9, 1933 in Birmingham, Alabama to the union of the late Jewell Evans and Walter Parker. Mearon was the youngest of eight children. Six of them, Willie, Warren, Walter, Lester, Percy and Sallie Mae whom she loved preceded her in death. Daughter Cassandra, granddaughter Tomika and great-great-grandson Devin Jr., have preceded her in death as well.

Mearon spent part of her childhood in Alabama and migrated to Detroit in the early 1940's. Mearon attended Detroit Public Schools. She graduated from Northwestern High School in 1951.
