Michael Jerome Hurston, a loving and devoted son, husband, father, stepfather, grandfather, brother, and uncle, was born on March 22, 1949, in Detroit, Michigan to Nathaniel Arthur Hurston and Sue Ellen Hurston (Gaut). On June 30, 2024, Michael went home to be with the Lord.

Michael's life was a testament to his unwavering faith and commitment to service. He accepted Christ at a young age and was baptized at Clinton Street Greater Bethlehem Temple Church in Detroit. Later in life he remained active in his church community, continuing to fellowship under Pastor Aaron Beal at New St. John Missionary Baptist Church.

From his earliest years, Michael displayed a remarkable sense of concern, responsibility, and a strong work ethic. Sensing a need to support his mother and siblings, he always found ways to earn money and took on various odd jobs, including several paper routes, and, while still in high school, working in downtown Detroit business offices, and night shifts at a retail store. Michael attended the Detroit Public School system and graduated from Southeastern High School in 1967. After high school graduation, he went to work at the same company as his father, Bower Roller Bearing Company. After a short stint at Bower Roller Bearing, he went to work for the Chrysler Corporation at the Lynch Road Assembly Plant as a production line worker and worked his way up to various executive level positions until his retirement

as a Human Resources Manager in 2005 after working more than 30 years with Chrysler.

He was a familiar face on the golf course and the bowling alley, always enjoying these activities with enthusiasm. When not engaged in sports, he loved cooking and sharing his delicious dishes, watching sports and old movies on TV, and being a great neighbor to all.

He earned both his bachelor's and master's Degrees from Central Michigan University and dedicated himself to transforming lives by personally recruiting and securing jobs for a countless number of individuals at Chrysler Automotive. His firmness, fairness, and generosity endeared him to all who knew him. He was known for his directness, love for his dog Scottie, and his willingness to help others without hesitation, whether through advice, financial support, or contributions to charitable causes – if he knew of projects that helped the underprivileged, he would contribute mightily without being asked.
