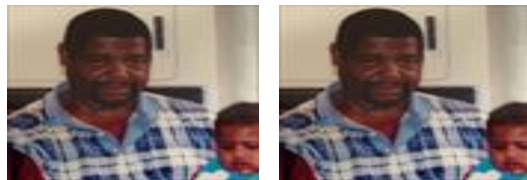
“ *To the Family of Mr. Milton Earl Caston*
