Minerva Pitts was born on April 12, 1955 in Detroit, MI to the union of Beauford F. Pitts and Joyce J. Pitts (both who preceded her in death) and sister, Lydell C. Eatmon who also preceded her in death. Minerva was the second of six children born into this union.

Minerva accepted Christ at an early age at Greater Future MBC in Detroit, MI under the leadership of the late Pastor E. C. Jones. She was actively involved in the junior choir and the usher board. She was educated within the Detroit Public Schools System and graduated from Martin Luther King Jr. High School in 1973.

Later that year, Minerva Pitts felt blessed beyond measure and became the proud mother of her only son Tonmie M. Pitts. As single parent a few of her heart's desires and goals were to ensure that her son became a God loving, God fearing, respectable, and responsible citizen within his community.

While raising her only son, she continued her education at the Detroit Institute of Commerce where she obtained her Associate Degree in Business Administration in 1976. She worked various jobs before she found her professional career at DTE Energy. She was a faithful and committed

employee that loved her job! She gave over 100% at work and her dedication was rewarded when she received a promotion in the Customer Service Department as a supervisor.
