Mitchell Chester Fields Jr. was born February 21, 1955 in Detroit, Michigan to Mitchell Sr. and Laura Mae Fields. He departed this life on August 3, 2018 at 10:05 A.M. in Atlanta, GA. He is preceded in death by his parents Mitchell Chester Fields Sr, Laura Mae Fields, two sisters Judith Ann Murphy, Jacqueline Sybil Smith, and a brother Manuel Henry Fields.

Mitchell accepted Christ at a very young age and was often seen in the pulpit at church with his late grandmother Annie Anderson, reading scriptures or even preaching a sermon.

Mitchell, affectionately known as Mike to family members and close friends and Bud to others, was raised in Detroit, MI and matriculated through the Detroit Public School System. At age 11, Mitchell went State level in the National Spelling Bee competition earning a gold inscribed dictionary. As a young teen, you would often see Mitchell sitting on the front porch drinking a Pepsi, reading the newspaper from front to back paying close attention to the stock market pages. He also loved baseball and basketball.

Graduating from Kettering Senior High School in 1973, he accepted a full scholarship with Pepperdine University in Malibu, CA majoring in business. Leaving Pepperdine after one year, Mitchell returned home to attend Oakland

University in Rochester, MI continuing his studies. In 1975, Mitchell joined the United States Air Force where he served honorably for 13 years in Inventory Management. After leaving the Air Force he continued to educate himself. At the time of his death, he held a degree in Business, and an Appraisal License.

Mitchell had a special love for children and had a nickname for his boys and all of his nieces and nephews. He was the jokester of the family and kept everyone laughing. He was the family encourager and could often be found giving uplifting words.
