Morris Johnson affectionately known as “Abdul Muhammad” was born in Camden, Alabama on December 4, 1942 to the late Percy Johnson Sr. and Clara Bussey Johnson. Morris accepted Christ at an early age, and later converted to the Muslim Religion led by the Nation of Islam. Morris attended Camden Academy in Camden, Alabama.

In 1962 Abdul relocated north to Detroit, MI and was hired at General Motors. After a few years of working for the automobile industry, Abdul went into entrepreneurship as a plumber. Abdul was also a Black Belt Karate Teacher. Abdul was one of Detroit’s most successful plumbers, and stayed in business until his health declined.

Abdul studied the teachings of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, and spoke fluent Arabic. At family gatherings Abdul always asked “Did you cook those greens in pork.” Abdul was close with all of his nieces and nephews, loved to give them dollars, and Whoppers from Burger King. Abdul enjoyed fishing, watching karate and western movies, riding his motorcycle in his younger days, and telling old stories from his childhood in the South. Abdul was

affectionately called “Unc” by his nieces and nephews. Abdul’s favorite sayings were “Hey you little darkie”, “Yessss” (when he answered the phone), and “Hey pretty lady” (Abdul loved the ladies).
