The people are everywhere smiling and asking if I need more water or my room cleaned for the third time in one day. The restaurant offers many choices of made to order high quality meals and a BBQ once a week. The resort has an infinity pool, a library, massage studio, bar, restaurant, a travel director, and a private restaurant called “The Jungle”. You can order anything cooked anyway for lunch or dinner and the meals are served in a private setting up 135 steps high in the jungle. Pim runs a perfect dive operation. He spends every night talking with the divers to see who wants to do what. Most dive days are spent on a boat with two or three divers, two guides and three boat workers. Bunaken Marine Park is the most pristine waters I have dove in with, in most cases, a gentle current with a few big things mixed in with billions of little fish, numerous nudibranchs, and colorful coral make it very sweet eye candy.
