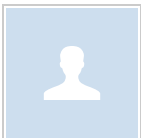

The greatest story ever told is the story of a man's life and the legacy that he leaves behind. This is the story of a man named Lacey Marion Brooks, he was the son of John Davis and was brought into the world by his mother Mary Lee Brooks, and he was born on the 24th of March in the year 1951. Lacey was the oldest son of his six other siblings three of which preceding him in death, (his sisters the late Marilyn "Pumpkin" Easley, Olivia Adkins, & Laird "Gail" Brooks). During his formative years growing up in the city of Detroit, Michigan Lacey was educated at Mackenzie High School where he completed his grade school education earning his diploma. Lacey continued his educational journey beyond the expectations of any black male at this time when he attended the Detroit Institute of Technology. He was a model student and was also the editor of the schools newspaper. During his time at DIT he was love-struck when meeting Joan Thomas, a woman who would be his wife, but not soon before finishing his education and earning an associate's certificate in Occupational Health and Safety. Accomplishing his educational goals Lacey decided to start a new chapter his life when marrying the woman of whom he was smitten on the 27th day in December in the year of 1985 at Tried Stone Missionary Baptist Church. Not leaving any significant detail of this life behind Lacey not only had a new life ahead of him with his new bride, but his love for motorcycles and the open road carried him to a career path that allowed him to see the nation, Lacey had become a truck driver for various companies for many years thereafter. However in a man's journey of discovery about himself it is never easy to come by, Lacey Brooks received a call to a higher plain of service but was called in the most intense way. A near fatal accident on the road and injury following the death of his grandmother during the same year turned his focus and his life completely over to serving the Lord. As a faithful servant Lacey became a church nurse, but his thirst for knowledge about God was deeper, so much so that he had begun studying closer the ways of the Lord under the guidance of Bishop Ned Adams Jr. of True Faith Church International a church that he and his family attended regularly. He

had become Bishop Adams' first adjutant, serving right beside him with honor and respect, soon after Lacey Brooks Sr. was an ordained Elder of the church in the year 1999. His many years serving the Lord he had helped cultivate a strong following in Christ as he had become a humble servant himself. Lacey loved serving the Lord by teaching the gospel to others. He had built a solid and special spiritual relationship with his Mother-In-Law Doris McCollum and her circle of friends, creating a daily prayer line in which they prayed with and for each other and the world around them. Lacey continued on in his journey and passion in the Lord at In His Presence Ministry Worldwide where he remained a member & elder until the time of his transition. He had a second chance at love when marrying his current wife Leigh Clayton (Brooks) on the 27th day of April in the year 2008. Leigh, another woman of virtue is who he spent his final moments with in this story. The story of this man does not stop here for he will always be remembered as a man of many words, and principals, who loved his family, and was known to speak many times on keeping the family together. Let us honor his memory and thank God for his time served here on earth, this man of honor has left to carry on his legacy his siblings; Malvia(Robert), Jessie(Rita), and LaDell, his 4 children Janine, Randy, Desiree(Tim), & Lacey Jr., His 3 step-children Andrew(Lynett), Angelette (Dominic), & Aretha(Raphael).
