“ *"Grandma Evelyn " was one of the most faithful people I have ever known. She once confided in me, that her grandparents? were freed slaves. She told me what it was like to grow up in the south BLACK. But she never complained she told me she knew someday Blacks would be Blessed & rise to fulfill a great purpose for God Almighty.*

She has 3 children, Ken the youngest.

During the hurricane of the Civil Rights storm, they lived within the eye of it, Detroit.

Evelyn had incredible courage, & intestinal fortitude.

When drugs moved into the neighborhood, she would move her family to the white neighborhood, to keep them safe.

It was hard, & i believe, dangerous, after all that was the 60's, blacks were still enduring unspeakable suffering due to racism, & it was not easy on the children. Some parents would make their kids come inside & slam the door when Ken went down the street.

Evelyn, went all the way to YANKEE Stadium on a Bus, with Ken & sat in the rain with us, as we paid tribute & honor to God in 1976.

When Ken was in coma, after accident on Donner's Pass where his van hit black ice, & he went thru the windshield,

Evelyn never left Ken's side, the entire 40 days. Even when doctors told her prepare the funeral, her faith never waivered. On the eve of the 39th day (ken coma was 40days exactly)

a young doctor told her let me do experimental surgery i believe i can save his life. Ken awoke next day.

Behind the scenes, Ken sister, was praying for him, with all her heart. Matt Morrison's mom stayed with Evelyn by her side praying. Dr Kim did a 40 day fast to save Ken's life.

Grandma Evelyn, being a humble woman had such dignity, brought her kids up by example, she prayed day & nite for her children, & never even considered anything being impossible. She was our families inspiration. She now dwells in the arms of the angels with

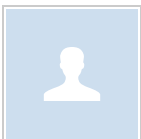
