For lunchdinner you have different types of fishes everyday (remember the sunday BBQ!!!), always cooked with fresh vegetables! And if you don't want fish there's always a meat alternative. You must also check the jungle restaurant up in the hill, but if you cannot because of a wheelchair they will be happy to cook whatever you prefer and serve you at your usual table in the restaurant.For my stay in Minahasa I was honored to have a personal assistant a nice guy who helped in every movement around the resort, he was always ready to take me to the restaurant for dinner, back to our room or the pool he was very helpful as everybody there, they all are willing to serve you the best they can, and they totally succeed!!!You don't need to think about nothing, they have everything you need, and I mean everything!
