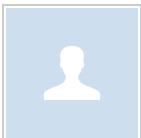

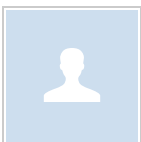

I hope that the words from the bible can give you comfort and know

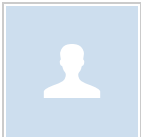
