



## Mr. Myron Williams

June 28, 1957 - April 9, 2013

Myron Williams was born into the union of the late Benjamin and Bettye Jane Williams on June 28, 1957. He was the second child born into this union. Myron confessed Christ at an early age and was baptized at Holy Cross Baptist Church in Detroit, Michigan.

In June of 1976, Myron graduated from Chadsey High School in Detroit, Michigan where he studied the Culinary Arts. He was gainfully employed by Manufacturers Bank (which later became Comerica Bank) as a maintenance worker for several years. Myron later established his own custodial business, Astro Janitorial Services, I and II, which he ran successfully until his death.

In 1989, Myron met Yvonne. They became friends and fell in love. He later asked for her hand in marriage. On June 25, 1994, they were united in holy matrimony at Bethel Temple Baptist Church, where they continued their Christian walk. In September 2007 they became faithful members of El Bethel Church in Redford, Michigan where he sang in the Male Chorus Choir and was an active member of the Prayer Partners Ministry.
