Her Story:

Myrtle Frances Wilson, the oldest of three children, was born on June 11, 1935 to the union of the late Henry Ann Hoosier and James Alexander Wilson in Clarksville, Tennessee. Her younger brother, Kenneth Wilson, preceded her in death.

Myrtle had been divorced from Lloyd Wilson for several years and was able to raise three children, Lloyd (who preceded her in death), Heleana and Mark. "Mama Wilson" also had several "affectionately adopted children."

Myrtle was educated in the Detroit Public schools system and received her high school diploma from Northeastern High School in 1953. Myrtle went on to attend Detroit Business Institute (DBI) with a concentration in Accounting.

Myrtle was employed for several years at McInerney Miller Bros. In 1968 she began her employment with Ford Motor Company and held various positions in accounting until her retirement in 1997.
