Nancy Ellen Hall-Moore, known to most as “Nan,” was born on October 23, 1925 in Springfield, Ohio to Walter Dewey and Lillian Mae Asher. Nan was the third of five children born to this union (Walter Jack, Constance Elizabeth, Donald Wallace, and Barbara May).

Nan graduated from Belleaire High in 1943 and would later move to Detroit, Michigan. There she would meet Kantchion Hall, Sr., whom she married on April 4, 1953. Together they had three children: Kantchion, Jr., Larry Jonathan, and Kathy Lynn. They were together for over 20 years until Kantchion, Sr. was called home on February 5, 1973.

Later, Nan met Montgomery “Mon” Moore. On March 10, 1989, they wed in Columbus, Ohio. For 15 years they lived in marital bliss until Mon passed away on May 30, 2004.

Nan was a member of New Prospect Baptist Church from 1961 until her passing (57 years) and an employee of the U.S. Postal Service from 1963 until she retired in 1987 (24 years).
