Odis James Hunt was born on March 7, 1953 in Shaw, Mississippi to Betty Lee Rencher and John Hunt. Odis accepted Christ at an early age. He was a member of Spangle Banner MB Church, Shaw, MS, where he was baptized and a faithful servant until graduating from high school. Odis attended McEvans High School. While in high school, Odis matured and was a basketball standout. After high school, Odis moved to Detroit, Michigan. Where he furthered his education attending Wayne State University. Receiving a Bachelor of Arts Degree with a minor in political science. Odis worked for the Detroit Board Of Education. Also worked for Guardian Alarm Company until his retirement. Odis always made sure he had his Sundays free so that he could attend church service. Odis was a faithful servant. He always helped meet the needs of others and remember that it is not about money or reward. He always ended a conversation saying repeatedly, "I Love You, I Love You, I Love You."

Rev. Odis Hunt was called to preach the gospel while attending Central CME Church, under Rev. Joe Louis Farrar. He was ordained as a deacon, then as an elder of this Zion in full connection. He has pastored Rosebrough Chapel CME Church on Wyoming in Detroit. Under his pastorate, Rosebrough was united with the Bunton Metropolitan CME Church being renamed Rosebrough-Bunton. Additionally, Rev. Odis pastored Peace CME Church, Detroit, Assistant Pastor at Allen Temple in Detroit, and returned to pastor

Bunton Metropolitan until his transition from labor to reward. The Lord set a fire down in his soul that he couldn't contain, that he couldn't control.
