Ollie Lovell Langston, was born July 28, 1931 in Carthage, Mississippi to Manson and Mittie Catherine Langston. Ollie accepted Christ at an early age.

After moving from Mississippi, Ollie attended the Detroit Public Schools. He graduated with honors and was the Vice-President of Northern High School's 1949 graduating class. After high school, Ollie attended Wayne State University. During his sophomore year, Ollie was drafted into the United States Army. He served in the Special Troops Command as a Medical Aid at Fort Benning in Georgia. He obtained the rank of Sergeant prior to his honorable discharge in 1955. Following his military service, Ollie returned to Wayne State University to complete his Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Math and Science, and a Master's Degree in Education.

Ollie was employed with Detroit Public Schools for 30 years as a mathematics and science teacher, and he also served as Science Supervisor in Waterford School District until his retirement in 1999.

He was joined in holy matrimony with Beverly Ann Langston for 60 years. To this union 3 children were born.

Ollie loved vacationing with his family. He especially enjoyed taking cruises all

over the world with his wife.

Ollie was an active and long-standing member of Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church.
