Opuarleodia Fisher Muckle, also affectionately known to many as Opple, was a woman as unique as her name. She departed this life on Sunday, October 30, 2016 after a battle with lung cancer. She was born on December 1, 1952 to Havit M. Fisher Sr. and Rosa M. Leonard. She was raised with her siblings Havit, Jason, and Ernestine Fisher.

She excelled in academics and graduated from Northwestern High School at the age of 16. She went on to attend Michigan State University on an academic scholarship and received her bachelor's degree in Education. Upon graduation, she began teaching for Detroit Public Schools until she transitioned into a career in the field of robotics and computer science where she dedicated five years of service.

She met her loving husband, Tyrone Muckle, while working as a seasonal employee at United Parcel Service in 1976. Their blessed union produced two children, Rosalena and Rochelle Muckle. Opuarleodia temporarily left the workforce to concentrate on raising her family. Thereafter, her desire to teach was so strong that she soon returned to the classroom. Over the next 20 years, she dedicated her time to educating hundreds of children in the Catholic and public schools of Detroit. In addition, she continued to further her

own education and received a Master of Education from Cambridge University in 1994. Her life was filled with pursuing her passions, which included science fiction, continuing education, reading, computer science, maintaining a strong relationship with God, and spending time with her grandchildren and family.
