Ottae W. L. Braggs, II was born on October 12, 1968 in Detroit, Michigan to Ottae William Braggs, Sr. and the late Edith J. Bell. He was the youngest child of seven siblings. He was baptized at an early age and later united with the Cathedral of the Most Blessed Sacrament Church.

Ottae grew up in Detroit where he attended school and was a graduate of Cody High School. At Cody he was a member of the school symphony orchestra, jazz and marching bands. His academic achievements earned him a scholarship to Tennessee State University where he majored in Criminal Justice and Music. Later he went on to the School of Engineering.

In September, 1997 he joined the Firefighting Division of the Detroit Fire Department and ascended to the rank of Senior Fire Engine Operator. He cherished being a firefighter and his dedication did not go unnoticed. Besides his passion for firefighting, Ottae loved cars of all kinds, especially race cars. He enjoyed dancing, listening to music and played several musical instruments. He also demonstrated affection for the Marine Corps. because of his father's dedicated service.
