Pamela was born on September 30, 1952 to the union of George Henry Bolden, Sr. and Rose Mae Bolden. Both parents, sister Rhonda Joyce Bolden and granddaughter Brandi Mitchell all preceded her in death.

After graduating Mackenzie High School, Pam attended and graduated from Shaw College where she played basketball and got the nickname "HOLLYWOOD." She attended Henry Ford Community College (Associate of Arts Degree in General Studies with Honors); Madonna University (Bachelor of Science Degree with High Honors, Master of Science in Business Administration Degree with the Leadership Studies in Criminal Justice).
