Patricia met the love of her life and married, Lloyd 'Sonny' Dove, who preceded her in death, and to this union her second child, Zaynid Dove was born.

Patricia's favorite hobbies were playing racquetball, drawing, painting, watching crime shows, talking Black politics, and enjoyed watching a good football and basketball games. She was passionate and loved sharing her knowledge of cosmetology to her students. 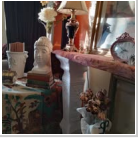
