Percy Shaw, Jr. was born on Tuesday, August 25, 1936 in Rosedale, Mississippi to the union of Maggie Alexander and Percy Shaw, Sr. He received his education in the Rosedale Public School System.

While growing up in Mississippi, Percy did the usual things that young boys did of that era, attend school, play with the neighbor kids, read comic books, shoot marbles, etc. But the fun had in the little town was to go to the "Picture Show" on Saturday nights. To pass the time on Sunday evenings, he and a group of the boys from Rosedale would travel and play baseball with other groups in nearby towns.
