She believed in my children as as I did in Ayisha--her beautiful angel. We laughed and cried together. She would correct me in love always. She called many days asking for us to pray together and we had some great times listening for God to speak. I learned so much from her. Absorbing the wealth of knowledge she so unselfishly shared. If she didn't know, she would research it and get back to me.

I miss you dearly and I have so much in me that you taught me. Thank you for being a light!!! I cried a few tears this mornings as Jesus did when he heard about Lazarus, but as I explained to my children, "Phyllis finished her race and she kept the faith!!!" To God be the Glory!!! We will meet again!!!
