His Story:

Preston Williams was born to the late Homer and Ethel Mae Williams. He attended the Detroit Public Schools and graduated from Southwestern High School. After high school, Preston married his high school sweetheart, Lillian Williams. They were married for 53 years.

After high school Preston was drafted into the United States Army. Preston served two years, while stationed in Munich, Germany. After military service, Preston went to work at Great Lakes Steel. Preston would later work and retire from Veterans Hospital.

Preston gave his life to the Lord and joined the Word of God Church Ministries in 2009.

Preston's favorite phrase when giving testimony at church was, "I said I wasn't going to tell nobody but." He often referred to his wife as "the boss."

Preston enjoyed working in the yard and sitting on the porch listening to old school music. His favorite artist was Johnny "Guitar" Watson. Preston also enjoyed playing cards and Dominos where he would send his victims to the boneyard.

Preston was known for taking pictures with family members and friends to

store for memories. He also enjoyed getting people's phone numbers just so he could give you a 3 a.m. phone call, just to let you know he was thinking about you.

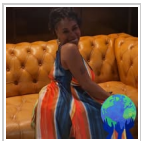
