Q.P. Mann was born October 22, 1941 to the late Josephine Mann of Union City, Tennessee.

He graduated from Miles High School in Union City in 1959, and received a Bachelor of Science degree in Secondary Education from Tuskegee Institute in 1964.

He married the late Lillie Watson Mann in 1964. They moved to Michigan in 1965 whereupon Q.P. was employed by Fisher Body for a number of years.

Q.P. received Christ in the late 1970's and shortly thereafter brought his family to Word of Faith Christian Center where he was a charter member. Eventually he served on the Deacon Board and was employed full-time at Word of Faith Christian Center for 28 years.

Q.P. was also an entrepreneur and businessman owning several profitable businesses such as the Party Barrel Party Store and Elite Porta-Wash.

Q.P. is survived by extended family and a host of loving friends.

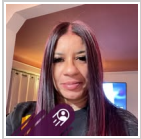
