Quvellar Knox was born May 21, 1934, to her loving parents Walter Cooley and Bettralean (nee-Richardson) Kirk in Chatfield, Arkansas. She was the fourth of ten children, the oldest sister. She spent most of her young life in Chatfield, Arkansas and received her early education in the Chatfield Public School System. Her family later moved to Sikeston, Missouri where she continued her education in the Sikeston Public School System.
