Celebrating The Life Of Pastor Ralph Kenneth Simmons:

The life of Ralph K. Simmons began on October 15, 1946 in Detroit, Michigan where he was the youngest of six children born to the late to Judge Richard and Bernice Simmons. Three of his siblings preceded him in death, Callie, Herman and Gene. Ralph surrendered his life to the Lord at the young age of 14 and accepted his calling to the Ministry in 1987.

He was faithful and about his Father's business in preaching and teaching the Gospel until his homegoing.

Pastor Ralph K. Simmons was Senior Pastor and Founder of Evangelistic Ministries Center. Because of his love for soul- winning and desire to strengthen Christians in their walk with the Lord, he worked tirelessly towards that goal by preaching the Gospel on Radio Stations 1440 and 1340 AM; Serving as Associate Minister, Bible Class Teacher, Sunday School Teacher, as well as substitute Christian Education Teacher at Pleasant Grove Baptist Church; he established a Drug and Alcohol Program while participating in and leading the Street Ministry; he was a traveling Bible Teacher at various sites such as the Detroit News, law offices, social service offices, Grace Hospital and MichCon in the City of Detroit where Christians at those sites took their lunch hour to study the Word of God.

Ralph was also a part of Evangelist Roosevelt Moore's Prison Ministry, participating in visitations to various prisons to fellowship, counsel, and preach to the inmates. He was instrumental in training and working with team members to prepare for the prison visits. He served as Assistance Pastor at the Open Door Rescue Mission. Pastor was also a member of the Berea Baptist Bible Institute. While at the Institute he was an Instructor where he taught classes on Theology and Hermeneutics to other pastors.

Pastor managed and oversaw the administration of classroom tasks such as preparing syllabi, tests, and routinely evaluated the students' progress.

Lastly, at Evangelistic Ministries Center, Pastor Simmons established a Bible Institute with a large tape ministry. He has written two books, The "Genesis Flood Controversy" and "The Revelation of Christ."
