“ I wanted to send our sincere condolences from the Detroit World Outreach church family on the tragic death of Deacon Rafael Hall and his daughter. This incident has hit our men’s ministry hard, especially those of us who co-labored with him at the Game Day events the last 2 years. This brought tears to the eyes of a few of us who got to know him. We considered Him a friend to DWO and well as a personal friend.

I wanted to share some thoughts concerning our time with Rafael. From first contact with him, you sensed a special man who was enthusiastic about serving God. A couple of our staff members who had brief conversations with him were very impressed with his spirit and his desire to see God show himself real in our joint events. Rafael was an all-in person when it came to making sure we had an event that was excellent that would have an impact on every man that attended. He was very detailed oriented and always put his hand to the plow. Yet, he was able to collaborate with the team to get the job done. The leader who worked with him in food service here spoke very highly of Rafael and totally enjoyed working with him.

There are some other personal observations I want to share. When Bishop Gibert passed, Rafael personally reached out to me and others here, praying for us and offering encouragement. That love and concern was so appreciated. When we had our first team meeting in December at the restaurant, a thing that stuck out was his love for his family. Much our fellowship surrounded discussion about how they were doing. He really cared for them as a man of God should.

A final observation you might appreciate concerns something I saw 2 days before this years’ Game Day Saturday event. On that Thursday, men from DWO and Citadel were setting up the building for the event. As Rafael looked at the floor in our building, he asked for a mop. Without batting an eye, he went ahead and mopped the floor. This would be something our maintenance men would

normally tackle. It didn't matter to him. We saw a need and he filled it. I guess he understood the words of Jesus in Matthew 20 that said the greatest of all would be the servant of all.

Know that the DWO staff and men's leaders are praying for Rafael's family.
