Raymon Howard Sterrett Sr. (affectionately called Ray). Raymon Howard Sterrett Sr., 78 years of age, passed on Monday, February 11, 2019 at Henry Ford Hospital, Detroit, Michigan after a long courageous battle with cancer.

Raymon was born on April 2, 1940 in Detroit, Michigan to the late Edmund Sr. and Wyolene Sterrett. He was the seventh of ten children, three preceded him in death. He was baptized in Jesus name at a young age with seven of his brothers and sisters at Greater Bethlehem Temple. He was educated in the Detroit Public Schools System in Michigan and attended Southeastern High School.

Raymon enlisted in the United States Navy in 1957 to serve his country until 1961. Raymon married Tecora Sterrett in 1960 and five children were born from this union. Two sons preceded him in death. Raymon was employed for 40 years at the Ford Motor Company Transmission Plant in Livonia, Michigan where he retired in 2001.

Raymon enjoyed his retirement by traveling and spending time with his grand, great-grand, and great-great-grandchildren. He also loved to visit the casinos in Detroit, Upper Peninsula of Michigan, and Canada. His favorite pastime was watching TV judge shows while relaxing in his recliner.

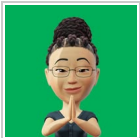
