Raymond William Moore was born on June 24, 1934. He was the second of three children born to the union of Wilbur and Louise Moore.

Both of his siblings, Donald Moore and Geraldine Powell preceded him in death. Raymond was raised on Detroit's "North End" where he returned in late 2017 to live with his great-niece, Shaton in the same home that he grew up in.

Raymond graduated from Cass Technical High School. After graduation, he enlisted in the Army, where he served in the Korean Conflict. While in the service, he traveled to Korea, Japan and Mexico. Raymond received a good conduct medal as well as being a sharpshooter. He was honorably discharged in the late 50s, and loved to tell of the stories from when he served.

Raymond was employed at the Department of Transportation and Traffic Court before ultimately going to engineering school and becoming a telephone technician at Michigan Bell where he worked for several years before retirement.

Raymond loved listening to Jazz musician Charlie Parker (Bird) as well as political radio. He also enjoyed crossword puzzles, reading and talking on the phone. He was very charming entertaining and loved by all who came in contact with him, family and friends.
