Richard Admiral Campbell was the second child born to Cleophas Campbell on December 14, 1942 in Slab Fork, West Virginia.

He was baptized at an early age by his uncle, Rev. John Gowen in Beckly, West Virginia.

He grew up in Beckly and attended Stratton High School. He enjoyed all types of music and was the lead trumpet player in the school band.

In 1961 after graduating, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps. He served his country faithfully for six and half years including a tour of duty in Vietnam. He was honorably discharged in September 1967 as a sergeant.

He moved to Detroit in 1967 and worked as a bank teller at City National Bank and at the State of Michigan as a social worker. He worked for the city of Detroit in the Water Department for 41 years and retired as head water plant operator June 2012. He attended Henry Ford Community College and was certified as an electrician. He was also a Detroit Police-Reserve Officer.

Richard's hobbies included: bike riding, softball, photography, bowling (he had honor scores) and ping pong (he was champ in the Marines).

He also enjoyed spending time with his family by talking them out to eat. He enjoyed good food and fine wine.
