Richard "Dock" Jordan, Sr. was born on December 24, 1944 in Detroit, Michigan to Thomas Jordan and Rubye Morris (both preceded him in death). He was one of seven siblings: Estelle, Alphonso (both preceded him in death), Maggie, Nathan (Reatha) Del, and Myrtle. Of all the siblings, he was known for dressing sharp and cutting a rug.

Dock was educated in the Detroit Public Schools system, where he graduated from Chadsey High School. Some of his hobbies included: singing, dancing, boxing, bike riding, skating, listening to his favorite music, DJing and grilling at family gatherings. One of Dock's favorite sayings was, "God is good all the time, and all the time God is good; and God is good 8 days a week." He will be remembered for constantly bragging on his children and grandchildren.

Dock met Cynthia in 1965. Later the two were joined in marriage and together they have four children. Even after divorce, they remained the best of friends. Together they taught their children to take care of themselves financially, love God, be good parents, put family first and the art of forgiveness.

Dock had many jobs throughout his life. In his early years, he shined shoes and was a meat cutter at Great Mark Western. Later he became an Insurance Salesman at National Life Insurance. In 2004, Dock retired from Detroit Edison after 26 years of dedicated service. He accepted Christ at First Baptist
