Richard E. White was born on May 15, 1945 in Chicago, IL to the late Alfred and Rosemary White. There were five siblings, three preceded him in death: Lavette Hudnell, Maurice and David White. In 1945 his family relocated to Detroit, MI.

Richard was educated in Detroit Public Schools, graduated from Wilbur Wright High School in 1963. He attended Henry Ford Community College and obtained his apprenticeship in machine repair.

On March 7, 1964 Richard was joined in holy matrimony to the love of his life, his childhood sweetheart, Lillie Barnes.

Richard was a loving providing and protective father of five children: Sharon, Richard Jr. who preceded him in death, Sheree, Derrick and Anthony.

In 1995 Richard accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior and was baptized by Bishop Gregory L. Foster at Kadash Baptist Church on Greenfield. In 2003, he rededicated his life to Christ and served faithfully as an usher and provided security during the week to ensure the safety of all who attended Thursday night events, especially for Gem's classes and the Well Walkers until his health failed.
