Robert graduated from Eastern High School in 1962. After high school, Robert began working in downtown Detroit until he was drafted into the United States Army in the fall of 1964. During his enlistment, he was trained to be an engineer with the 293rd Battalion in Baumholder, Germany. He was trained and worked to provide clean water for the city of Baumholder.
