Robert Johnson also known as "Charlie, Uncle Charlie, Shortman, Skipton" was born to Guiata Gabbidon and Eadley Johnson on June 1, 1944 in Alexandria, St. Ann, Jamaica. He attended Alexandria Schools in St. Ann Jamaica. He later moved to Kingston in 1969 to make a better life for himself and did trade work in upholstery. This was also when he met Nora Moncrieffe and formed a union which produced four children; Colin, Anthony, Dameon and Dane. In 1979, Nora and the three older boys migrated to the New York, and in 1981 Robert joined them and seven years later Dane was born, they lived in Brooklyn, New York. Here he worked as a plumber, carpenter and an all round tradesman.

He was a very disciplined and respected man in the community where he lived and worked, he instilled in his children good values, his words to them was "always strive to be number one, as number two is the first loser". He was loved by all who came in contact with him in New York. After he and Nora separated, he came to Detroit, Michigan, to visit his niece, Deonne and this is when he met Monica Bailey (Princess), his fiancé. He was best known here in Detroit as Uncle Charlie, everyone here in Detroit loved him. He was fun but he was also a man that did not stand for foolishness. He was about business.

Robert departed his life on May 17, 2018.
