Celebrating The Life Of Robert Tucker:

Robert Tucker was born on August 2, 1922 in Mobile, Alabama to the union of Luther Tucker and Arvetta Simmons.

He accepted Christ at an early age and joined New Bethel Baptist Church in Detroit, Michigan where he was baptized by the Reverend C.L. Franklin.

He attended school in the Mobile, Alabama School system, and entered the United States Army in 1941. He obtained the rank of Sergeant in the 93rd outfit as Duty Field Chief of Section 350 Field Artillery and was honorably discharged in 1946.

In 1946 he moved to Detroit, Michigan and obtained a job at Ford Motor Company. He then worked at Standard Tube as a Straitner Operator until he retired in 1983.

He helped form the VFW Local 9715 around 1950. Robert was an avid sports fan enjoying golf, fishing, hunting, football, basketball and baseball.
