On May 7, 1948 in Detroit, Michigan, Robert Allen Webster was born to the union of Colonel K. and Callie Pearl Webster. Robert, better known as “Allen”, was the second child of five. Colonel K. and Callie Pearl preceded him in death. His brothers; twins, Byron and Myron, Donald, and James, and his half-sisters Barbara and Shirley preceded him in death.

Allen was once a very shy and quiet person, but that all changed after retirement. He caught the bug of “Gift to Gab”, and there was no cure for him. He loved attending Chew Family Reunions with his mother. He enjoyed listening to Motown old school music. Allen enjoyed visiting the older family members here in Detroit. They would always have a sandwich or full course meal for him. He always had some type of stuffed animal and other gifts when he visited, and when they could not decide which one they wanted, he

laughed, and said “take them all”.

Allen leaves to treasure his memory a very special cousin Dorothy Scott, a special nephew, James Webster, Jr. Foremost, his “Gift to Gab” to his cousins (who kept him laughing), Elizabeth, and John in Tennessee; Martha in Alabama; Kim in Maryland, and Sheila in Virginia.
