Unfortunately, we will not be able to attend the service. Our thoughts are with Rodney's wife and daughter, as well as all of the rest of his family.

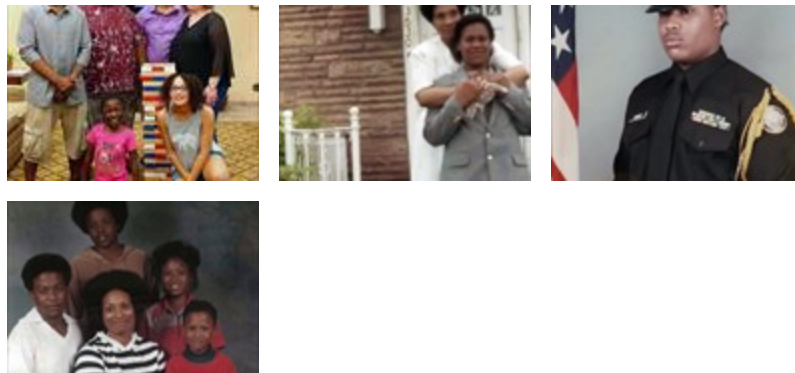
Goodbye Rodney. You went to your well-deserved rest way, way too soon.
