Rodney Derrick Gooden Sr. made his home going on Saturday March 28, 2015. He was born on May 1, 1957 in Highland Park, Michigan, to Willie and Tena Gooden. They had 5 children; Debra, William, Rodney, Cassandra and Issaac. He was a resident of Detroit for many years, prior to moving to Westland, Michigan. He graduated from John J. Pershing High School in 1975, where he served as a Reserved Officer Training Corp. Leader. He attended Mopar Technical Vocational School where he received his Skilled Trades License. He was employed at Chrysler Motor Division as a Skilled Tradesman. He also worked at Detroit Medical Center, St John's Hospital, the Thirty Six District Court and the City of Detroit as a Boiler Operator. He was a member of the Operation Engineers Local # 324. Also a member of King Solomon Grand Lodge Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, where he obtained his 32nd °. He gave his life to Christ at an early age and was baptized at New Mt.
