Celebrating The Life Of Roger Lamar Abrams:

Roger Lamar Abrams was born on October 28, 1929 in Clarksdale, MS To the late John B. Abrams and Udoxia Abrams. He was the fifth of seven children, all of whom preceded him in death.

Roger received his education in the Clarksdale, MS public school system. After graduating from high school, he was drafted into the U.S. Army where he served from 1950-1953. He was honorably discharged.

After his discharge from the service, he moved to Detroit where he became employed by Chrysler Corp. where he worked for 49 years 8 months and 23 days until he retired in 2002.

In 1955, Roger met and married the love of his life, Louise (Clark) Abrams (whom he called "Honey Bunch") To this union, two children were born, Denise and Anthony. His son "Tony" preceded him in death. They were married for 63 years before his passing.

Roger joined Central CME Church on August of 1964 when Rev. Homer Draper was Pastor. He enjoyed attending early morning service when it was available. He was accepted as an honorary Men's Club member.

He loved his family and friends and was loved in return by family and friends.

God called him home on September 17, 2018.
