Rosa was baptized at an early age and accepted Christ as her personal Savior. She became a faithful member of the Morning View Missionary Baptist Church in Detroit, Michigan in 1949 under the leadership of the Reverend George W. Baker. Rosa served her Lord dutifully as a member of various choirs. She also kept the records as Secretary and Financial Secretary and looked forward to giving the announcements on each Sunday.

Rosa received her education in the Detroit Public School system and attended Northern High School.

Rosa met the love of her life, Edgar Rencher, in 1950. They were married on June 16, 1951 and were blessed with three beautiful daughters. They would have celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary this June.

Rosa was a dedicated wife and mother who enjoyed taking care of both the house and her family for many years before beginning work at Annis Furs, which was located in downtown Detroit. Before retiring from Annis Furs, she

became the first African American to manage a new store located in the Northland Mall.

An infectious smile and a willing heart was no coincidence when it came to Rosa. That was just her! Always thinking of others, she had the unique ability to make everyone feel special. Some people are just like that! Rosa was one of them.

Rosa enjoyed travelling and was known for loving the casinos, here in the Detroit area and outside the State of Michigan. She was also an avid bowler and was fondly nicknamed "Rosebud."
