Roscoe and Helen moved to Detroit, Michigan in 1965 where he worked for Ford Motor Company at Wayne Assembly Plant Local 900 in Wayne, MI until

his retirement in 1997.

Roscoe was highly respected and admired by family and friends whom many looked at him as a father figure.

In December 2017, Roscoe graciously walked into the hospital which became a month and a half of twist and turns as he had the hospital staff scratching their heads on his will to live.

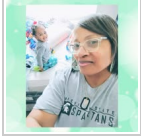
