Rosetta (Rose) Lee Hannah was born January 17, 1944 to the late Rosetta Robinson Caver and Jack Campbell at Tuskegee Institute. At the time of her birth, she had two brothers Willie Lee Campbell and Burrell Caver who preceded her in death. She later had a sister Maxine Campbell who also preceded her in death.

Rosetta left Lomax, Alabama at the age of nine and moved to Detroit, Michigan where she was raised by her aunt and uncle.

Rosetta graduated from Central High School in 1962. She later went on to graduate from Alma's Beauty College with a certificate in Cosmetology in 1982.

September 30, 1965, Rosetta was joined in holy matrimony to the late Herman Hannah. They raised five loving daughters.

Rosetta became a faithful member of New Hope Missionary Baptist Church in 2011. She served in the Intercessor Ministry. She also belonged to Springhill Missionary Baptist Church for over 23 years where she served on the Usher Ministry and sang in the choir.

Rosetta loved to crochet and made quilts for the Cancer Society. She was known as Mama Rose because she was a mother figure to all that came in her presence.

Rosetta made her transition on June 5, 2014 at Henry Ford Hospital.
