Rosetta accepted Christ at an early age. She joined John The Baptist Church of Orville, Alabama where she served on many boards and loved working for the Lord. Her passion was cooking, where she was employed by Hugh Shannon Cafe of Selma, Alabama where she met the love of her life William (Sonny) Moultrie through serving a large chicken sandwich in 1964. They developed a relationship, which led to marriage in 1965, where Rosetta mastered the way to a man's heart through his stomach and later from this union three children were born, one son Melvin E. Moultrie who preceded her in death. Upon moving to Detroit, Michigan two daughters were born, Dianna and Tara Moultrie.

Rosetta was employed by John and Johnson for a number of years and was later employed at Frank's Nursery and Crafts Warehouse until they closed. Later she continued to pursue her passion of cooking. She loved family gatherings, caring for her yard, garden and pets, along with raising her

grandchildren and great-grands, where she's affectionately known as “GG” and “Big Auntie.” She was well known for her collard greens, fried chicken and homemade dressing.

Rosetta later joined New St. Paul Inspirational Temple in 1999 under the leadership of Rev. K.M. Early.
