



## Mrs. Ruby Bell Caudle

March 12, 1924 - January 6, 2017

Our dear, loving and beautiful mother was born on the 12th day of March, 1924 in Montgomery County in the state of Tennessee to Alfred and Nora Simpson. She was one of eight siblings; Andrian, Alton, Alfred, Henry, Johnnie, Cullen and Chinesta; all preceded her in death.

She accepted Christ at a very early age. She was educated through the Clarksville, Montgomery County, Tennessee school system.

On the 6th day of July, 1946, Ruby married Scott Caudle Sr. in Hopkinsville, Kentucky. They were happily married for fifty three (53) years, until 1999 when God called him home.

Shortly after their marriage in 1946, they moved to Detroit, Michigan. They were blessed with three children; Dorothy, Scott Jr. (who preceded her in death) and Mary Ann.

In 1947, she became a loyal and dedicated member of Greater King Solomon Missionary Baptist Church, under the Pastorships of Robert Bradby Jr., William G. Reed and presently, Willie J. Pitts. She served faithfully on the Nurses Guild No. 1 for approximately 50 years, until her health slowly

declined.

Our mother was a great, wonderful, neat and very clean homemaker. She never, ever cooked without her apron. She loved cooking, baking and canning. Everyone loved her sweet potato pies and homemade ice cream.

In her younger days, she belonged to a Ladies Social Club who gathered together once a month to play Keno. She also was a loyal member of "The Tennessee Day Club of Detroit, Michigan." She always loved to hear spiritual songs. She loved God, her family, her pastor and church members.

She departed this life on the 6th day of January 2017 at Royal Oak Beaumont Hospital.
