Celebrating The Life Of Samuel Thomas Herrington:

Samuel Thomas Herrington, he was known as "ST" to his family and friends. Seventh child of the late Rev. Burney Bell Herrington and Mrs. Myna Lee Calhoun Herrington. He was born on January 28, 1922 in Sardis, Georgia. Last of eight children to pass in this union.

Samuel attended Sardis Elementary. In December 19, 1942 Samuel entered the Armed Services at Ft. Benning, Georgia. He served in the United States Army during World War II in Normandy and Ardennes in Northern France. He also served in the Rhineland, a region in Germany. After his service with the United States Army, he received commendations for his service consisting of the American Theater Service Ribbon, World War II Victory Medal, the EAMET Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. He separated from the United States Army in November 1945.

He was employed at Scott Paper Company formally known as Kimberly Clark for 30 years as a machine mill operator.

Samuel was united in holy matrimony to Ethel Howard on September 28, 1948. Ethel preceded him in death. His son John Thomas Herrington also preceded him in death.

In 1946 Samuel joined Union Second Baptist Church in River Rouge, Michigan. Later, on April 19, 1987, he joined Bethany Baptist Church under the pastorship of Samuel H. Bullock in Detroit where he was an active member, driving the school bus, volunteering and studying to become a deacon.

Samuel enjoyed hunting, caring for his many hunting dogs. He enjoyed gardening, sharing his labor of love generously with neighbors and friends.

After a short illness, Samuel passed away December 26, 2015 at Notting Hill in West Bloomfield, Michigan.
