Virginia on February 28, 1933 to Gracie Mae and Wilfred Moore. She was an only child. She lived in Beckley W. Virginia with her cousin Lonnie Coleman, Jr. Their aunt Goldie Coleman, and grandparents, Preston and Sarah Coleman, help to raise her. Her mother later married Joseph Penn who was lovingly called "Daddy Buddy." Gracie and Daddy Buddy nurtured and raised her to adulthood. Her parents preceded her in death. She was educated in the Beckley School System.

In 1949 as a young adult, she fell in love with and married her handsome husband, Jerome Thomas Davis, Sr. To this union was born five children; her husband preceded her in death. Sarah was so happy that God blessed her with Loyal Anthony as her second loving and devoted husband. This union combined two great families that became one. Loyal also preceded Sarah in death.

Due to the tender love and care that she received from her mother-in-law, Clatie Mae Anthony, she received salvation and served the Lord with all of her heart everyday of her life. Sarah served faithfully in the Kingdom of God. She got her ministerial beginnings under the tutelage of Mother Rosetta Black. She was a top student from the Aeon Bible College. Sarah was also a student of Wayne County Community College with an Associate's Degree in Occupational Therapy. Sarah worked for a few years as a Sorter at the United States Post Office.

Our early memories of mom are praying, studying the Bible, and reading all the books she could get her hands on about God. Books were a common place on the dining room table and throughout the house. The other thing that was commonplace about Mom was her dedication to her family. She was a very present mother, grandmother, granddaughter, daughter, daughter-in-law, niece and cousin. Mom always took care of her family by caring for those who had become ill, birth of new babies, family gatherings, graduations, birthday parties and everything in between. She truly loved and adored her family.

On the evening of September 10, 2018, her heavenly father called her home. During her transition to heaven, she was surrounded by family and friends.
