Mother Wyatt was born on September 3, 1905 in Powers, Arkansas. She was the fourth of 14 children born to the parentage of the late Deacon John Henry and Mrs. Mary (Coleman) Johnson. Twelve of her siblings have preceded her in death: Arthur, Mrs. Eliza Vaugh, Mrs. Arie Smith, Mrs. Parilee Heard, William, twins, Annie and Nannie, Mrs. Sawilla Murphy (1985), Columbus, Wavier, Arbrady and Mrs. Arletha Jackson.

Mother Wyatt's very formative years were gained at the Guernsey High School, in the Powers Community. She professed her hope in Christ at St. Luke Baptist Church and was baptized by the late Rev. J. H. Wyatt.

For economic reasons, she migrated to California during the early 1940's. She eventually moved back to Arkansas where she was united in holy matrimony

to Mr. Emanuel Wyatt on April 28, 1952. They migrated to Detroit, Michigan during the year of 1953. She immediately cast her lot with Messiah Baptist Church on Humboldt and Poplar under the guidance of Rev. Scott. She has remained a faithful member of this church for more than 60 years. She is now the oldest member in age and membership.

During her walk with Christ, she has sang here with the Arcappla Choir, served on the usher board and made visits to the sick and shut-in. She always supported her church faithfully under every pastor.

Mother Wyatt was a very loving person, sowing seeds of kindness and joy. After her health declined, a staff member always came by her home to fellowship and serve communion.

She very peacefully departed from this life into the arms of Jesus on Tuesday, May 13, 2014 in Hospice at Sinai-Grace Hospital.
