Rev. Shedwrick Miller was born September 23, 1924 to the late Bishop Alexander and Mother Artemessia Miller of Royal Oak Township, Michigan.

He received his formal education in the Ferndale School System. He later attended divinity school pursuing the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

On December 27, 1940, he married the love of his life, Katherine Murray. That union lasted 72 years and was only separated by her passing in 2013. They enjoyed raising their three children; Ina, Arnold, and Tina, along with many foster children. While raising their family, he served as a Deacon of their church and went on to become a Pastor of St. Vincent Chapel in Clinton Township, Michigan and later St. Paul AME Church in Southwest Detroit. He was also employed by Gulf Oil Company and later by the Detroit Board of Education, from which he retired.

With his wife by his side, they enjoyed serving the Lord, visiting the sick, gardening, cooking, and traveling.

In October 2014, “The Pearls of Wisdom” organization honored Rev. Miller as one of the former residents of Royal Oak Township over the age of 90.

Even in his wavering health, he was very faithful and devoted to his wife when her health started declining.
