Steve Alexander Fulton, affectionately known by family as "Rick" or "Ricky", was the firstborn to the union of Steve C. and Alice Fulton, on December 14, 1943, in Detroit, Michigan.

He accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Mt. Olive Baptist Church Detroit, Michigan.

Steve fulfilled his educational requirements through the Detroit Public School System, graduating from Eastern High School. He furthered his education by attending Wayne County Community College and Oakland County Community College.

On January 4, 1964 Steve married Colleen Dukes. Two children were born to this union, Jarrett and Darrice.

Steve served in the United States Air Force from August 1962 to May 1967, receiving an honorable discharge.

Trained and nourished in the ways of our Lord and Savior, Steve became an active member in the Mt. Olive Baptist Church. He coached Mt. Olive youth in basketball, brought a deep bass voice to the Mt. Olive Male Chorus and

served Mt. Olive in the Trustee Ministry for many years.

Steve was employed by Detroit Edison/DTE Energy for 34 years starting in as Stockman, progressing to Dispatcher, Area Supervisor of Underground Lines and retiring as Facilitator/Instructor in 2001.

Steve was fun loving and enjoyed spending time with family and friends. He was a sports enthusiast basketball, football, baseball, hockey, he loved it all! When he wasn't watching sports on TV, he was playing basketball, coaching basketball, refereeing basketball, he coached women's baseball, he loved to go bowling and camping. Golf was his pride and joy.

In 1974, Steve and a group of his sports minded friends started a baseball team. During there winning season they formed a Social Club to raise funds for uniforms. It went so well the club remained intact, naming themselves the Centrifugal Force. Starting small and moving outward accomplishing much for their team.

Steve made his transition on Sunday, March 24, 2013.
